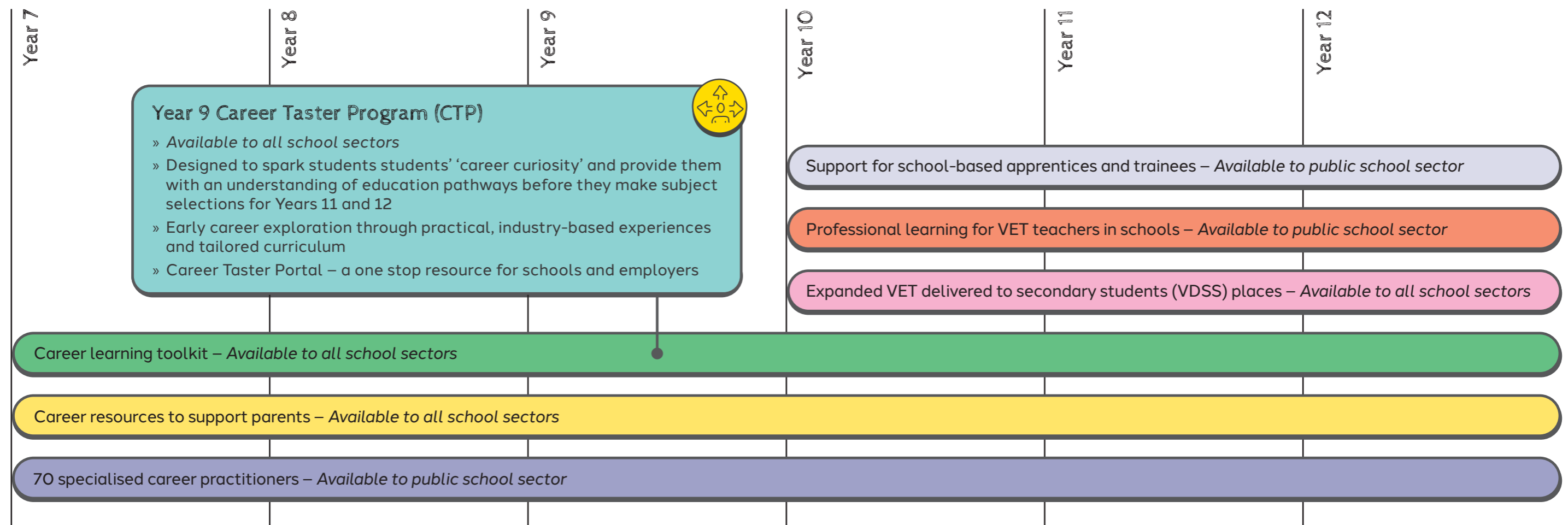


Education and training election commitments across the student journey

The *WA Jobs Plan* outlined several key initiatives aimed at strengthening the vocational education pathways and career development in schools. These election commitments are being delivered by the **Department of Education** and the **Department of Training and Workforce Development**, providing support throughout a student's secondary schooling. This visual diagram demonstrates the education and training election commitments for secondary students and their parents and schools.

Career resources to support parents

70 specialised career practitioners

- » 70 career practitioners employed in public schools
- » Career practitioners will complete a Graduate Certificate in Career Development Practice
- » Will build strong career development culture in schools

Support for school-based apprentices and trainees

- » Financial assistance to support school-based apprentices and trainees to complete training
- » Covers costs for transport, food, clothing, personal protective equipment, educational and practical supports

Professional learning for VET teachers in schools

- » Up to two weeks industry placement for VET teachers/trainers
- » Up to four weeks for school-based VET teachers/trainers delivering under an RTO auspiced arrangement

Expanded VET delivered to secondary students places

- » VET qualifications delivered in secondary schools expanded to an additional 4,000 places by 2024
